However, they are frequently overlooked or inconsistently maintained by the facility because their importance to the manufacturing or processing at facilities is not always recognized. The resulting deferred or sporadic attention, results in unnecessary costs and non-compliance risks. This presentation will reinforce the value of air pollution control systems to facility operations. Specific opportunities and evaluation approaches for finding and curing deficiencies are identified and discussed for various types of systems.
